Primary activities for the Scholar will include:

- Providing training to organizational leaders in team-based implementation strategies and/or training to clinicians in evidence-based autism interventions
- Participating and leading IN STEP Center consultations about implementation science and team effectiveness research methods
- Engaging with partners from community-based and/or health system service provider organizations
- Supporting project and Center logistics
- Participating in and/or leading qualitative and/or quantitative methods activities

- PhD or equivalent in clinical psychology, special education, public health, social work or related field
- Strong interest in implementation science and the implementation of evidence-based interventions in children's mental health service settings
- Relevant experience with implementation training or facilitation
